

Costs and service information on Applications under the Immigration Rules

Including:

- Start Up visa and Innovator visa
- Tier 1 Investor visa
- Turkish Businessperson visa
- Family visa (spouse and partners applications, including fiancé(e)s or proposed civil partners)
- Applications for Tier 2 work visa, business visa or Tier 4 study visa

Our fees

On average, the above types of work take between 5 to 20 hours to complete. This means that on average costs are between £1,500 and £10,000. All figures exclude VAT unless specifically stated. Our hourly rates are given below:

The exact number of hours it will take depends on individual circumstances in your case, including the amount of supporting evidence that we need to consider, whether you are applying with other dependants and how much assistance is required during and post application (such as helping you obtain police registration certificate).

What services are included?

- Discussing your immigration status in detail and confirming whether this is the most appropriate application for you to make and what other options may be available to you.
- Giving you advice about the requirements of the Immigration Rules.
- Considering the supporting evidence you have provided (the amount of hours depends on the number of documents and whether any additional documents are required).
- Where necessary, helping you obtain further evidence (such as medical records, criminal record certificates and bank statements).

- Preparing your application and submitting it on your behalf (anticipated to take 2 to 3 hours).
- Dealing with any additional enquiries from the Home Office.

Disbursements (not included in costs set out above);

Disbursements are costs related to your matter that are payable to third parties, such as visa fees and immigration health surcharge. We handle the payment of the disbursements on your behalf to ensure a smoother process.

The costs quoted here do not include:

- Any Home Office application fees. You will pay this to the Home Office directly as part of the application process.
- Advice and assistance in relation to any appeal if your application is refused.
- Any other fees in connection with the application but for our professional fees.

How long will it take?

The initial information gathering stage may take from 2 to 8 weeks, depending on how quickly you can supply all the documents.

We cannot guarantee how long the Home Office will take to process your application. We will notify you of the current processing times at the time of the instructions.

We can usually submit this type of application within 2 to 4 weeks of you instructing us, however we notify you at the earliest opportunity if it is likely to take longer than this.
